



## University of Lille - Master Biology and Health Science Academic year 2025-26 Prepare your application

This document is not an application nor a registration form. It allows to prepare your application and gather the required documents. Applications are exclusively online via the e-candidat<sup>1</sup> application available by the link <a href="https://ecandidat.univ-lille.fr">https://ecandidat.univ-lille.fr</a> from May 12 to June 12, 2025. Beyond this date, it is no more possible to apply.

## Parts to inform:

- your identity
- your personal details: post mail, phone and email
- the university you come from
- details of your academic curriculum. In particular, you have to mention which teaching units (courses) you have validated in M1 and send a copy of the certificate of successful completion of the M1 as well as original or certified academic transcripts of the courses validated in M1
- your degrees certifications, if you have already completed an another master degree or an another academic training for research
- the name of the research unit in which you will carry out your research project
- the name and the position of the supposed supervisor of your project in the research unit.

## The following documents must be attached to the application:

- 1 Detailed Curriculum Vitae
- 2 Copy of your identity document
- 3 A cover letter
- 4 Copies of diplomas, certificates of achievement, original or certified transcripts
- 5 The written and signed prior agreement of the head of a research unit<sup>2</sup> for the M2 research project.
- 6 A letter from your future supervisor<sup>3</sup> in which he/she agrees, if your application is successful, to supervise you during the M2 academic year
- 7- A summary of 250 words maximum of your M2 research project (title, background, objectives, methods, expected results) written on the standard form downloadable on the website of the M2
- 8- An official certificate of academic achievement or an ENIC-NARIC certificate of comparability in the event of a diploma other than a Master 1 in Biology or Biology-Health obtained in France.

The application is formatted to automatically request a certain number of supporting documents.

Thanks to select "not concerned" for the following ones and only those:

- Certificate of French language
- Education regime identification form
- Internship certificate, except if you have already made a M2 internship

- E-level diploma transcript.

For the section "Relevés de notes après le BAC": put only academic transcripts of L3 and M1 (or degrees of similar level).

<u>The M2 must be completed over one academic year</u>. If for exceptional reasons, you wish to achieve it on 2 years, you need to include in your application a motivated request co-signed by your future supervisor.

Deadline for applying is June 12, 2025, at 23:59.

Final registration will only be allowed after the favorable opinion of the admission committee which will meet in early July 2025. Answers will be sent by email no later than July 15, 2025. In the event of a positive opinion, you must confirm or resign within one week.
